“We are saddened that Don will be leaving our Board after such a long and distinguished tenure,” said Dan Ulliyot, M.D., chairman of the five-member governing body. “His experience, expertise and commitment to meeting the health care needs of the residents of our communities will be sorely missed.”

The District Board accepted Director Newman’s resignation at a Public Board meeting last night.

In tendering his resignation, Dr. Newman noted “It has been a pleasure and an honor to have served the residents of the District for all these years. My colleagues and I are proud of the new hospital that now sits on District land, as well as the many community funding initiatives that have been launched over the past 10 years. I look forward to attending the ground breaking next year for the new assisted living and memory care facility the Board is building on its 1600 Trousdale property.”

The Board voted unanimously to launch an appointment process to fill the remaining two years of term (2010-2014) and a Nominating Committee was appointed.
