**FORMER BURLINGAME MAYOR FRANK PAGLIARO ELECTED TO

**BURLINGAME, CA, February 1, 2017:** Former Mayor of Burlingame Frank Pagliaro, Esq. was officially sworn in as a director of the Peninsula Health Care District (PHCD) Board of Directors at its Regular Board Meeting held December 8, 2016. Pagliaro was elected to the PHCD Board of Directors in the November 2016 San Mateo County election and replaces Cameron Emmott, M.D.

He has a J.D. from University of Virginia School of Law and a Bachelor of Arts from University of Vermont.
