Dear Neighbor,

Our Board Chair, Lawrence Cappel, wrote to you back in August of this year about The Trousdale, the assisted living and memory care facility that the Peninsula Health Care District is developing at the corner of Trousdale and Magnolia. The site had been fenced and cleared in preparation for the beginning of construction, but we were delayed by the need to reduce construction costs.

Fortunately, the Board of Directors was able to determine a way to reduce the cost by changing some of the building's design elements. These changes will not impact the appearance or quality of the facility, and we will still be able to build an attractive yet reasonably priced senior care facility.

The City of Burlingame approved our initial application last November. Since there have been a few changes to the original design, we will be submitting an amendment to our previously approved plan to the Planning Commission on November 23rd. We are hoping to start construction soon and to be able to welcome our first residents early in 2018.
